The newly released, envisioncda.org, is Coeur d'Alene's visioning and long-range planning project website created to help develop a roadmap to the future and a citywide plan to serve our community from 2020-2040. We are just beginning this project and are looking for volunteers to serve our community either as a Focus Group member or as a member of the Community Advisory Committee (CAC). Submitted applications will be selected to ensure that the community is well represented on the committees.

In addition to these opportunities, Envision Coeur d'Alene will offer a variety of surveys, community meetings, visioning sessions, mapping exercises, and much more. This project is anticipated to be complete by December 2020. Stay tuned for public meetings in various locations and formats to get the entire community involved. The first such event is the Launch Event, which will take place on Thursday, September 26 from 5:30 p.m. -7:30 p.m. at the Innovation Den (418 E Lakeside Ave).
